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Theme 4 - In The Beginning Part 4: Cain and Abel



- Parent and child share the follow up activities for others to hear (eg. What they learnt about 'the fall' of Adam and Eve, and what it means for them.)
- Cain and Abel's relationship with God and each other. Day 6 of creation day song.

Activities



- Bible story: Read Cain and Abel booklet and discuss eg. using questions below. Give pictures of Cain and Abel bringing offerings to God for child(ren) to colour, with letters / words to practise writing on the back (eg. Good gift)
- 'Give God Your Best' colouring activity. Give 2 colouring pages of a bowl of fruit to each child. Tell child they have 1 minute to colour the first picture as fast as they can. Then give them more time to complete the second picture, and tell them to do their best colouring. (Or use modelling clay to do the same activity). When completed, ask child(ren) which one God would like best. Then ask which one they would give to God, and why?
Explain that although we can't always get everything right, God wants us to do the best we can and with a cheerful heart.
- Creation song Day 6 – Teach child(ren) verse 6 of the creation song, reminding them of previous verses. Discuss Day 6 questions (see Day 6 sheet). Remind child(ren) of the difference in the way that God made and related to man from the way He made and related to the animals (see Genesis chapter 1 verses 24-27, Genesis chapter 2 verses 7-8 and verses 18-22).

Discussion Questions

1. Abel was a shepherd, looking after the flocks of sheep, what did Cain do?
2. Both sons brought gifts to God. Was God pleased with both gifts?
3. Why wasn't God pleased with Cain's gift?
4. How did Cain feel when he saw that God accepted his brother's gift but not his?
5. Why is it right and important to give gifts (especially to God) in the right way?
6. What are some ways that you could show that you are giving your best?

Extra Activities for Theme 4

Suggested Activities:



- Re-read Genesis chapter 4 verses 1-17 from the children's bible, little by little using discussion questions (eg. see previous page) for recall.
- 'Giving My Best' fun activity about making good choices. (see activity sheet)
- Colour picture of Cain getting angry because God does not accept his sacrifice. Talk about the right way to react when we get things wrong. Help the child(ren) remember a time when they have responded a) well b) badly, to correction and / or tell them something that's happened like this to you. (Practice writing words to go with picture.)
- Give a gift or two: Ask child(ren) to choose to do something nice for one or two people this week, like make up a basket of fruit, or a cake, or draw a picture (it may be for someone who needs cheering up). Ask them to give the best they can, and explain that God is happy when we put our heart in to giving a good gift.
- Creation song Day 7 – teach verse 7 (final verse) of creation song, and discuss Day 7 questions (see sheet). Fill in letters on picture for writing practice.

Prayer Points



- Thank God for reminding me to do my best, and for giving me people who care enough to remind me, and correct me when I'm wrong.
 - Ask God to give me a heart that wants to serve and love and make others smile.
- Ask God to help others to know what pleases Him.


Cain and Abel

accepted"




Cain's anger didn't go away.

attacked Abel - and killed him!





He Called The **Dark** Night.




On Day Number 2

And gave him charge of all around.










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Children's Sunday School Activities Index - Giving My Best

GIVING MY BEST

A fun activity to show how making the right choice is always the best.

TOPICS: Behavior, Child of God, Choices, Pleasing God

MATERIALS: 3 sheets of paper, marked with the letters A, B, and C

DURATION: Approximately 10 minutes

PREPARATION:

Select three corners or sections of the room, and mark with one of the paper sheets displaying A, B, or C

WHAT YOU WILL DO:

Explain to the kids you will read several situations, and that they have to choose the right answer.

Explain what the best choice would have been after everyone has given their answer.

1 - Your mom tells you it's time go to bed, do you

- A) Say, "Not now, I'm busy"
- B) Go right to bed
- C) Don't know what to do

2 - You finish playing with your new toy, that has many pieces, do you:

- A) Walk away and do something else
- B) Ask your older brother or sister to put it away for you
- C) Put the toy away neatly before doing something else

3- You are visiting relatives and for dinner they give you something you don't like, do you:

- A) Eat a bit and thank them for the food
- B) Stomp your foot down and push the plate away
- C) Tell them you hate it and ask for something else

4. A friend comes over and wants the same toy you are playing with, do you:

- A) Keep the toy for yourself
- B) Keep the toy and ask your friend to play together with you
- C) Give the toy to your friend and pick something else
