## Theme 3: - In The Beginning Part 3: Adam and Eve Disobey God



- Parent and child share the follow up activities for others to hear about (eg. Recall bible story with questions, show colouring of pictures)
- Day 5 of creation – creation song.
- Adam and Eve disobey God, who puts them out of the garden.

### **Materials Needed**

- Bible(s) suitable for children
- Child Safety Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Card, Tinsel, Pipe Cleaners
- Toilet Roll Tubes
- Large Cardboard Box (Washing powder box etc)

- Picture of grass, flower, bushes cut from magazine, old calendars etc
- Creation Song Days 1-5
- Day 5 Question Sheet
- Angel with flaming sword template
- Picture of 2 trees for the middle of the garden

- Items to make a serpent puppet - from a sock, with button eyes and string tongue
- Creation Day 5 Song Handwriting Sheets
- Picture of Eve reaching for fruit to colour

## Theme 3: - In The Beginning Part 3: Adam and Eve Disobey God



### Bible Verses:-

Genesis chapter 3 verses 1-24

### Story: The Start of Man's Sadness

### Activities



- 'The Start of Man's Sadness'.- Read the booklet about the fall of man, and use discussion questions for recall. (Refer to children's bible if needed)
- Arts and craft – make 'angel with flaming sword', with paper template and card, tinsel 'wires', etc. Help child with cutting out and sticking. (Make 'Garden of Eden', by preparing materials beforehand:  
1 large washing powder box eg. 2.6 kg size – cut in half lengthways and covered with pictures of grass / flowers / bushes, cut from magazine or old calendars, etc. Make 2 trees for middle of garden from cardboard or picture stuck on toilet rolls. Make 'serpent' – cut out and stick on card).
- Play – perform the story of the fall with child(ren), using the Garden of Eden, trees and characters prepared.
- Introduce and discuss the 'Care Rules', using the 4 sheets provided.
- Creations song Day 5 – learn verse 5.

### Discussion Questions

1. Which tree did God say that Adam and Eve must NOT eat fruit from?
2. Why do you think that God gave this rule?
3. What did God say would happen if they ate from this tree?
4. What happened when Adam and Eve disobeyed God?
5. Why did God put an angel with a sword at the entrance to the garden?
6. What's another word for disobeying God?

## Theme 3: - In The Beginning Part 3: Adam and Eve Disobey God

### Extra Activities for Theme 3

#### Suggested Activities:



- Read Genesis chapter 3 verses 1-24 from the children's bible, a little at a time, using discussion questions for recall.
- Re-enact the story using the arts and crafts garden and characters. Make additions to the garden (eg. Trees, animals) and a 'serpent' from a sock, with button eyes and string tongue, if desired!
- Go through the care rules and questions about doing right, and relate it to times at home or school when caring or uncaring behaviour has resulted in happy or sad outcomes. Make 2 or 3 new 'Care Rules' for home.
- Creation song Day 5 – go over verse 5 and fill in the writing on the picture. Stick or draw fish, sea creatures and birds onto the picture (or on reverse side). Rehearse verses 1-4 of creation song.
  - see Day 5 questions to discuss.


#### Prayer Points




# GOD MADE EVERYTHING!

When God made the first man, Adam, he lived in the Garden of Eden with his wife, Eve. They were perfectly happy obeying God and enjoying His presence until one day ...





After Eve disobeyed God she led Adam to eat the fruit also. Adam should have said, "No! I will not disobey God's Word."







When Adam and Eve sinned, they both knew they were naked. Sewing fig leaves into aprons, they covered themselves and hid in the bush from God's presence.

One day Cain brought God some vegetables as a gift. Abel brought some of the very best of his sheep as his gift to God. God was pleased with Abel's gift.




God was not pleased with Cain's gift. Cain got very angry. But God said, "If you do what is right, will you not be accepted?"

attacked Abel - and killed him!





Cain went out from the presence of the LORD. He was married to a daughter of Adam and Eve. They raised a family.




Soon, Cain's grandchildren and great-grandchildren filled the city that he founded.



Meanwhile, the family of Adam and Eve grew quickly. In those days, people lived much longer than today.




When her son Seth was born, Eve said,

years and had many children.




In the world, people became more and more wicked as one generation followed another. Finally, God decided to destroy mankind and . . .

God knows we have done bad things, which He calls sin.



Him to forgive your sins, He will do it! He will come and live in you now, and you will live with Him forever.


If you want to turn from your sins, say this to God:



And with many **Birds** that fly.




On Day Number 6,

**Don't** throw things.




## Care Rule 2

**Don't** kick, push or hit.




# Care Rule 3

**Do** ask nicely for things.




**Don't** grab.




