Theme 10 - A Wife for Isaac



- Parent and child share some of the things they did from the last theme.
- what they did as follow up in the week for others to hear (eg. What signs of God's love they've noticed around them, pictures they've made, etc).
 - How God can help us make good friendship and family bonds, like He did for Isaac and Rebecca.

Materials Needed

- Bible(s) suitable for children
- Colouring pens/pencils, animal and man stencils (Bought or home-made using cardboard cut-out of people and animal shapes)
- Modelling clay (optional)
- Bible Booklet - A Wife for Isaac - Options to print as A5 or A4 booklet to colour or already coloured
- Giving your best 2 colouring activity pages of bowl per child
- Giving your best activity sheet (making good choices)
- Creation song Day 6
- Creation song day 6 writing sheets

Story: A Wife for Isaac

Theme 10 - A Wife for Isaac

Activities



- Story – A wife for Isaac – read and discuss booklet. (see questions below) use Genesis chapter 24 from children’s bible to add detail.
- ‘Give God Your Best’ – colouring activity. Give 2 colouring pages of bowl of fruit to child(ren), telling them they have one minute to finish it, (so it’ll be messy!) Then give them more time to complete the 2nd picture, and tell them to do their best colouring. (Or use modelling clay to do the same activity). When completed, ask child(ren) which one God would like best and why? Explain that although we can’t always get everything right, God wants us to do the best we can with a cheerful heart, like Rebecca did at the well.
- Creation song Day 6 – Teach child(ren) verse 6 of the creation song, reminding them of previous verses. Discuss Day 6 questions (see Day 6 sheet). Remind child(ren) of the difference in the way that God made and related to man from the way He made and related to the animals. (See Genesis chapter 1 verses 24-27, chapter 2 verses 7-8 and verses 18-22).
Draw picture using animal and man stencils.

Discussion Questions

1. What did Abrahams’s servant do to help him find the right wife for Isaac?
2. What did Rebekah do that made the servant know she was to be Isaac’s wife?
3. Why do you think that was a good sign to ask for?
4. Read and explain who Jesus said was His real family from Matthew chapter 12 verses 46-50.
5. Read and explain what Jesus said made His disciples change from servants to friends (from John chapter 15 verses 13-15).
6. What do you think makes a really good friend?

Extra Activities for Theme 10

Suggested Activities:



- Re-read Genesis chapter 24 (especially upto verse 25) from the children's bible, little by little, using discussion questions for recall.
- Creation Day 6 – practice writing words from verse 6 of creation song (see sheets).
- 'Giving My Best' fun activity about making good choices (see activity sheet.)
- Give a gift or two: Ask child(ren) to choose to do something nice for one or two people this week, like make up a basket of fruit, or a cake, or draw a picture (it may be for someone who needs cheering up). Ask them to give the best they can and explain that God is happy when we put our heart into giving a good gift.

Prayer Points




- Thank God for good friends and family.

A Wife for Isaac




Abraham and Isaac returned home. Some time later, sadness came. Sarah died. Abraham had lost his wife, and Isaac had lost his mother.




After the funeral,



GIVING MY BEST

A fun activity to show how making the right choice is always the best.

TOPICS: Behavior, Child of God, Choices, Pleasing God

MATERIALS: 3 sheets of paper, marked with the letters A, B, and C

DURATION: Approximately 10 minutes

PREPARATION:

Select three corners or sections of the room, and mark with one of the paper sheets displaying A, B, or C

WHAT YOU WILL DO:

Explain to the kids you will read several situations, and that they have to choose the right answer.

Explain what the best choice would have been after everyone has given their answer.
