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Theme 14 - Joseph Part 3 – Joseph’s Family Reunion.



- Asks child(ren) to share some of the things they did from the last theme.
- God brings about the way for Joseph to be reunited with his family. Joseph’s brothers are reminded of their wrongdoing, but Joseph loves and forgives. The whole family come to live in Egypt.

Activities



1. Bible story – read 'Joseph's Family Reunion' booklet with child(ren), using discussion questions for recall.
2. Child(ren) colour picture of Joseph's reunion with Jacob in Egypt and practise writing words / letters.
3. 'Gathering the lost sheep' activity – Explain how God loves to gather His people like a shepherd gathers his sheep together (see Matthew 18 verses 11-14). Child(ren) to make shepherd and sheep with materials provided, and act out the parable.

Discussion Questions

For example:

- What did Joseph do to make sure his brothers would come back to Egypt? (Page 1 of booklet)
- What did Joseph's brothers think was happening to them? (Page 2 of booklet)
- What trick did Joseph do to get his brothers to bring Benjamin to Egypt? (Page 3 of booklet)
- How did Joseph know that his brother's were sorry for what they'd done to him? (Page 6 of booklet)
- Do you try to make things better when you fall out with someone, even if you think it's their fault? Read what Jesus taught about forgiveness in Matthew chapter 6 verses 14 & 15 and Matthew chapter 18 verses 21 & 22

Extra Activities for Theme 14

Suggested Activities:



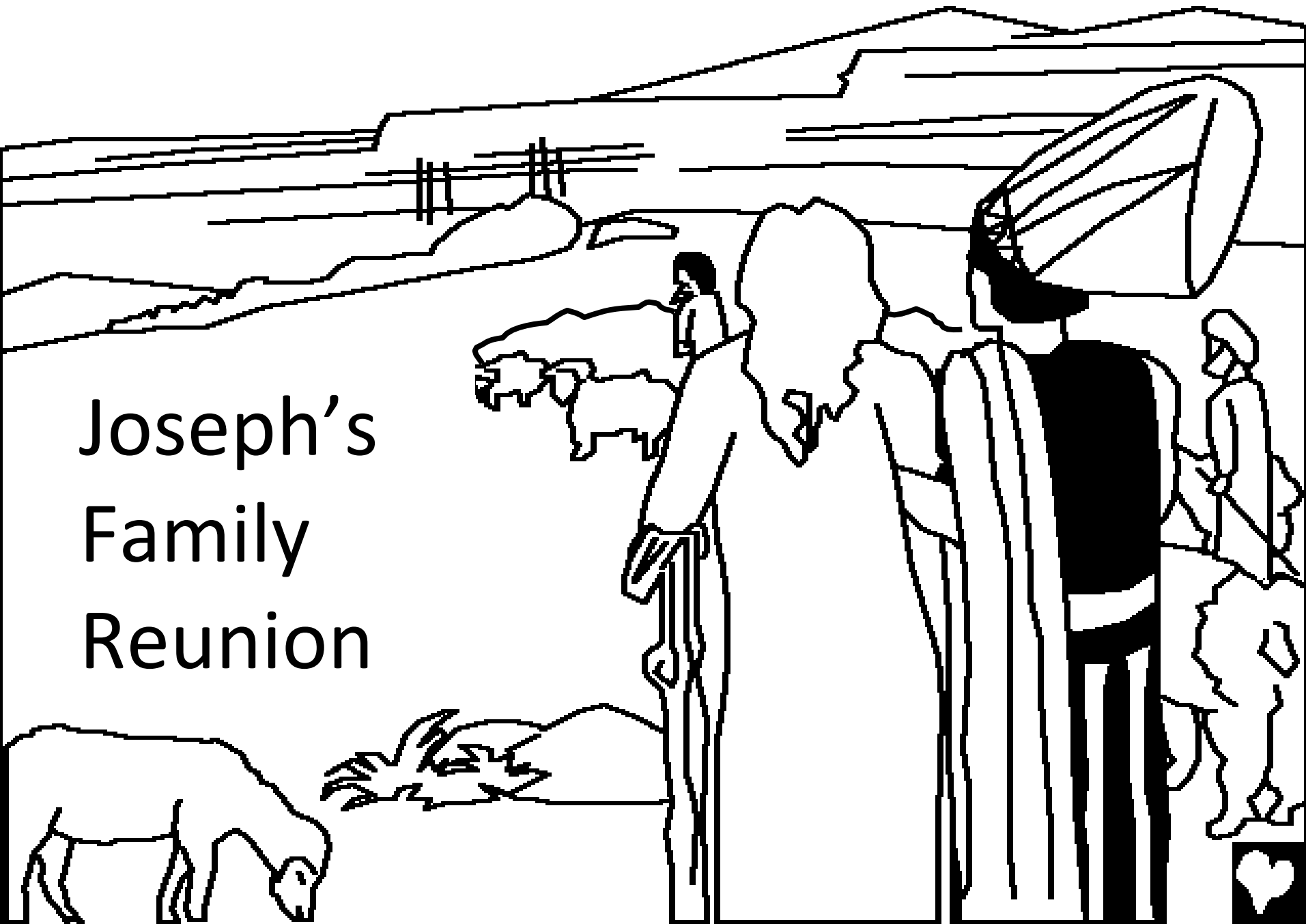
- Re-read booklet or chapters from children's bible, bit by bit with questions for discussion. Child(ren) can colour booklet.
- Talk to child(ren) about jealousy – what it is, and how it can make us do mean things to people. Talk about what will help us to stop feeling jealous, and what will help us to feel better, even when people treat us unfairly (including prayer and remembering how people like Joseph behaved, and was comforted and honoured by God, who was pleased with him.) Talk about forgiveness.
- Jacob's family – counting and colouring exercise. (see accompanying sheets)

Prayer Points

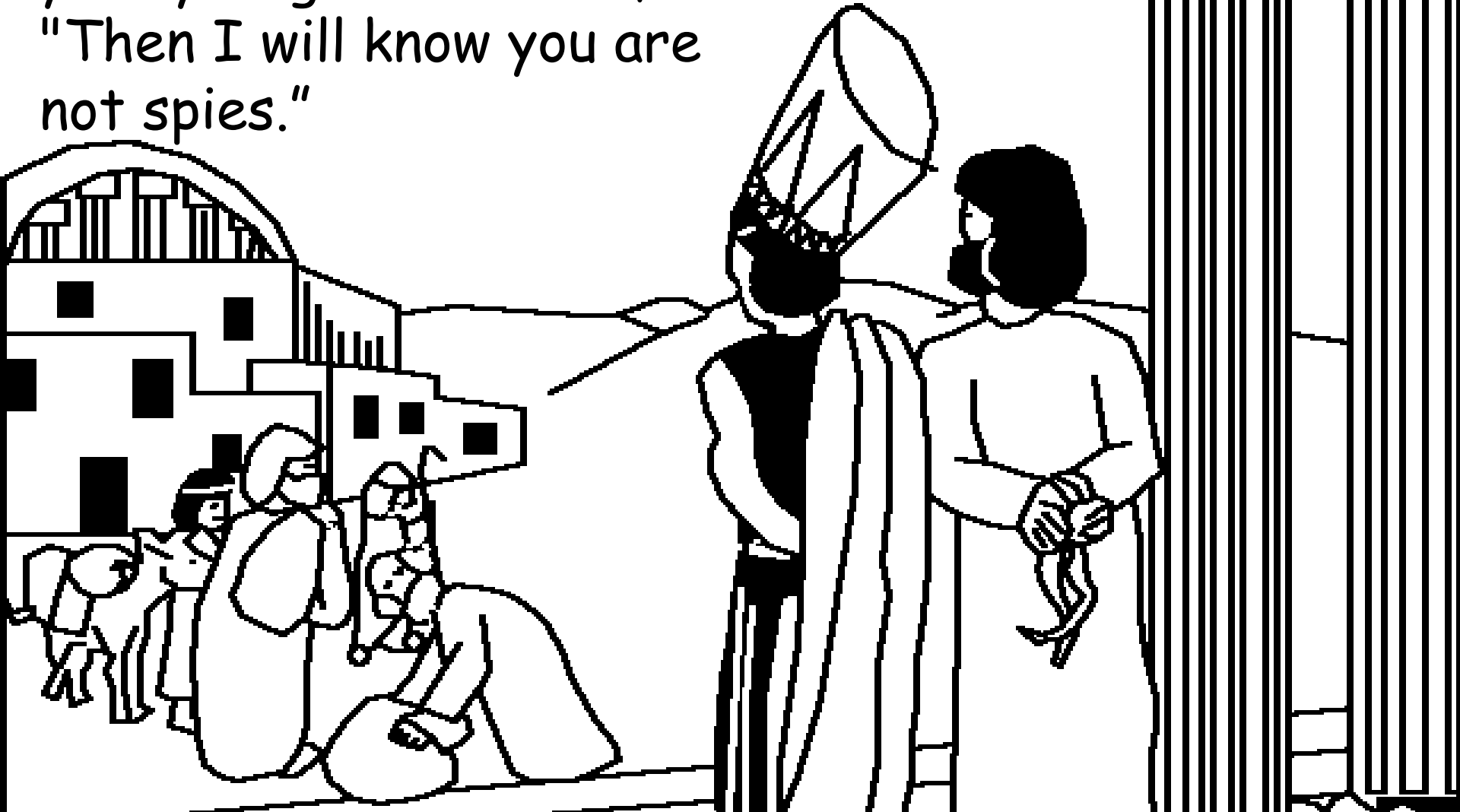


- Thank God that He loves us, and shows that love by making a way for us to be forgiven, when we own up to what we've done wrong and are sorry.
- Ask God to help us to remember that He will make everything fair in the end, even if people are not always fair, so we don't need to be jealous of anyone.
- Ask God to help us remember to quickly make up with people that we fall out with, and be quick to say sorry when we're told off, or have hurt someone.

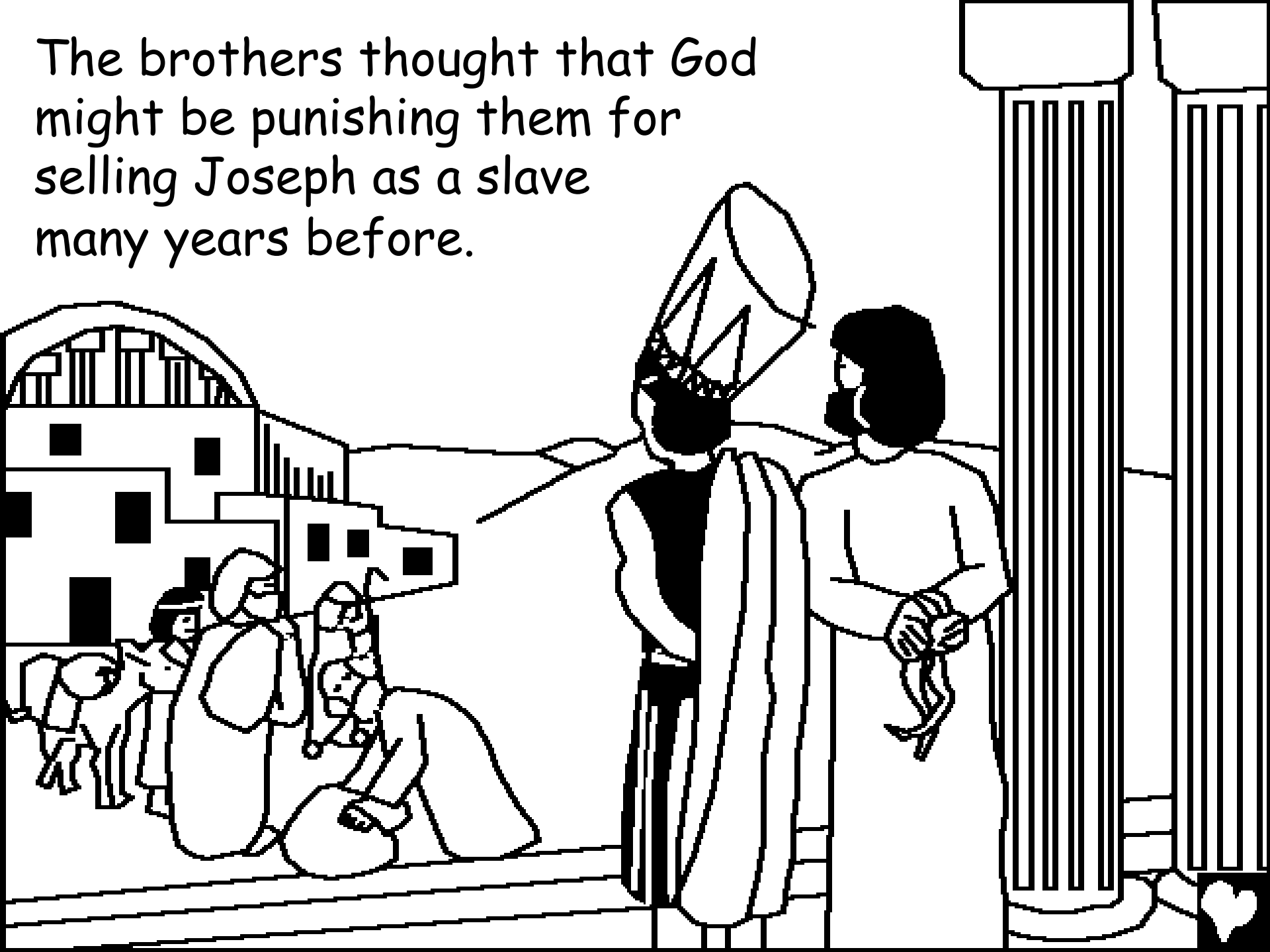
Joseph's Family Reunion

not spies."

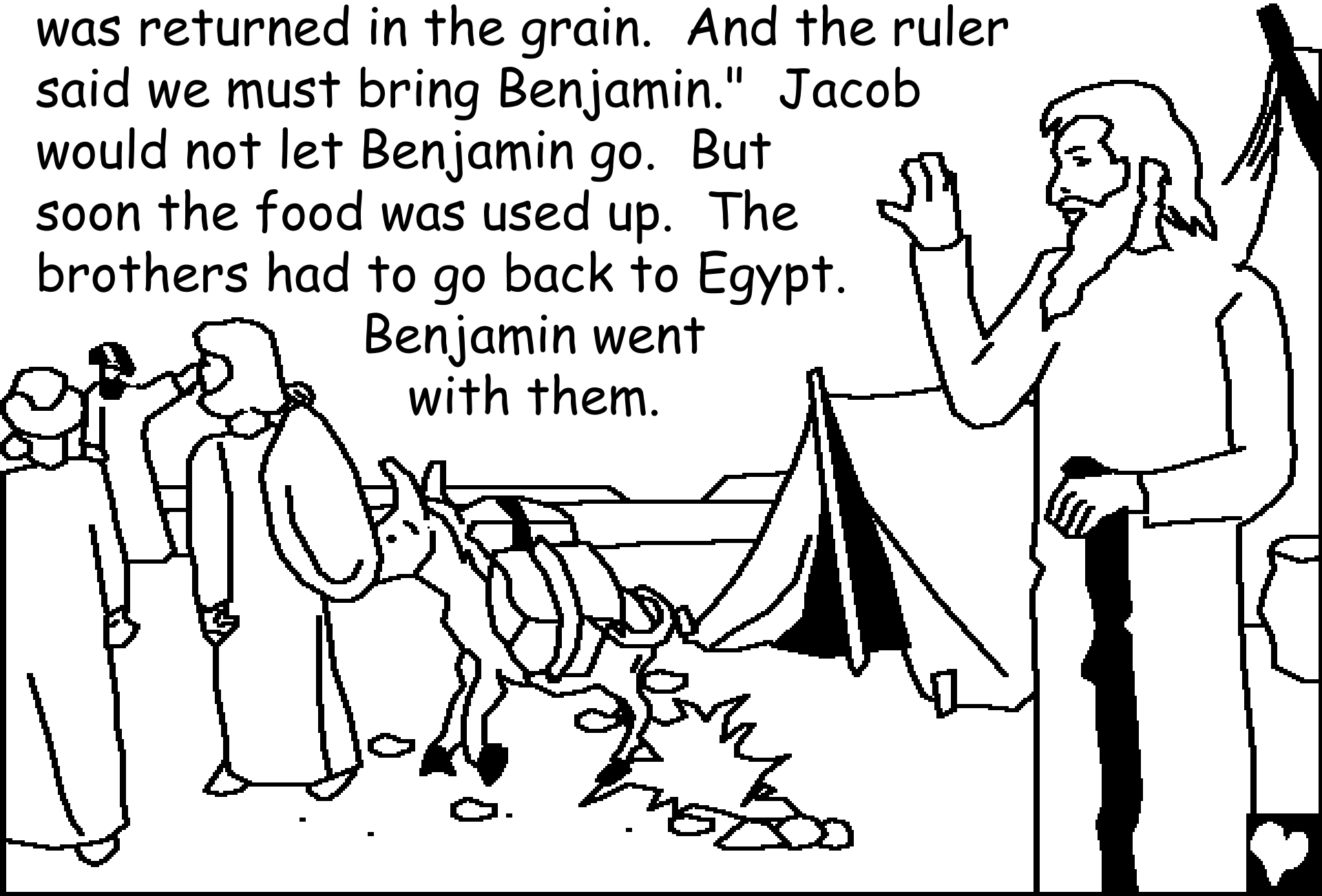


The brothers thought that God might be punishing them for selling Joseph as a slave many years before.

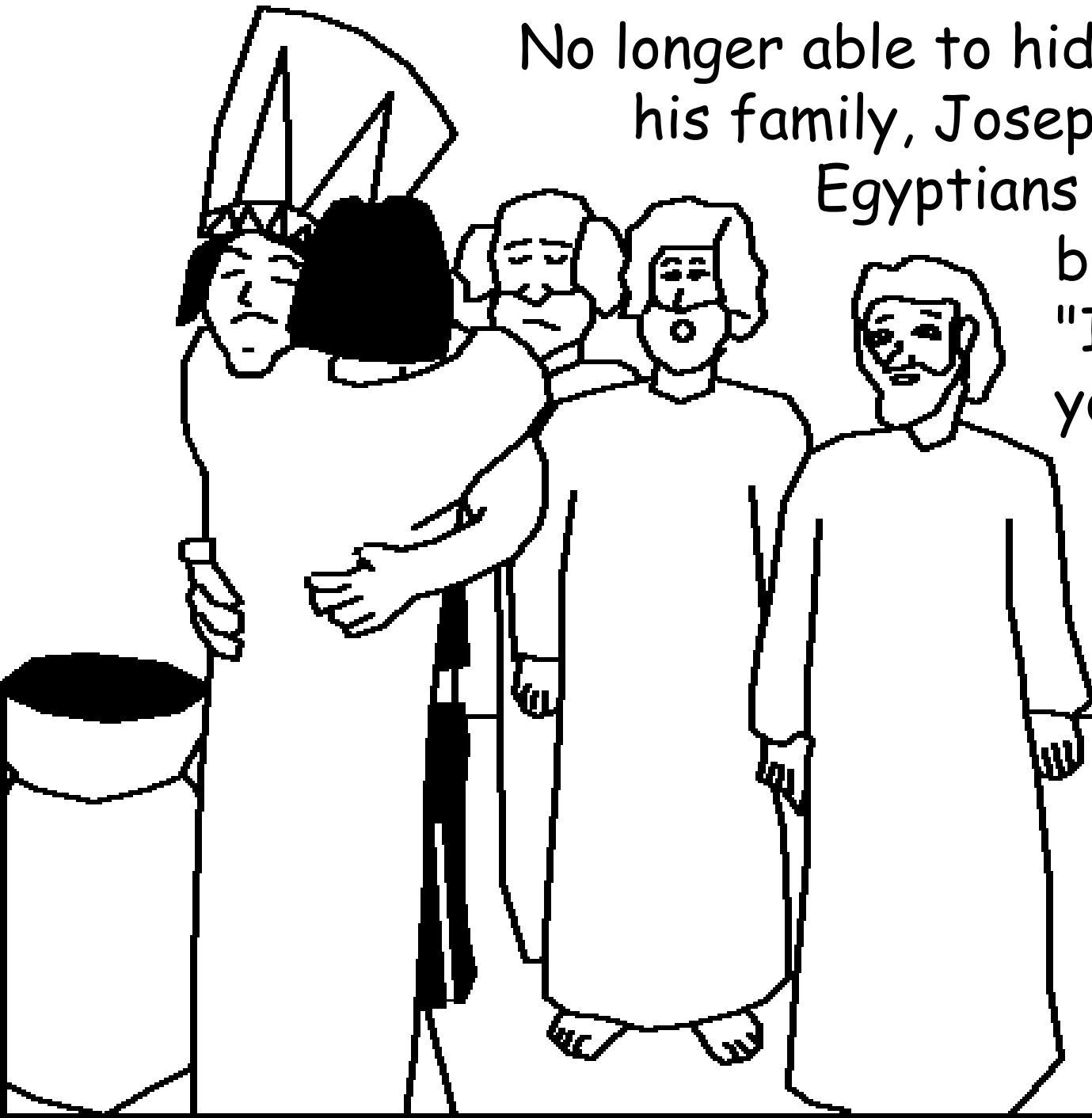

Joseph said. "My lord, take my life instead," begged Judah. Joseph knew that Judah, who had suggested selling Joseph, was truly changed.



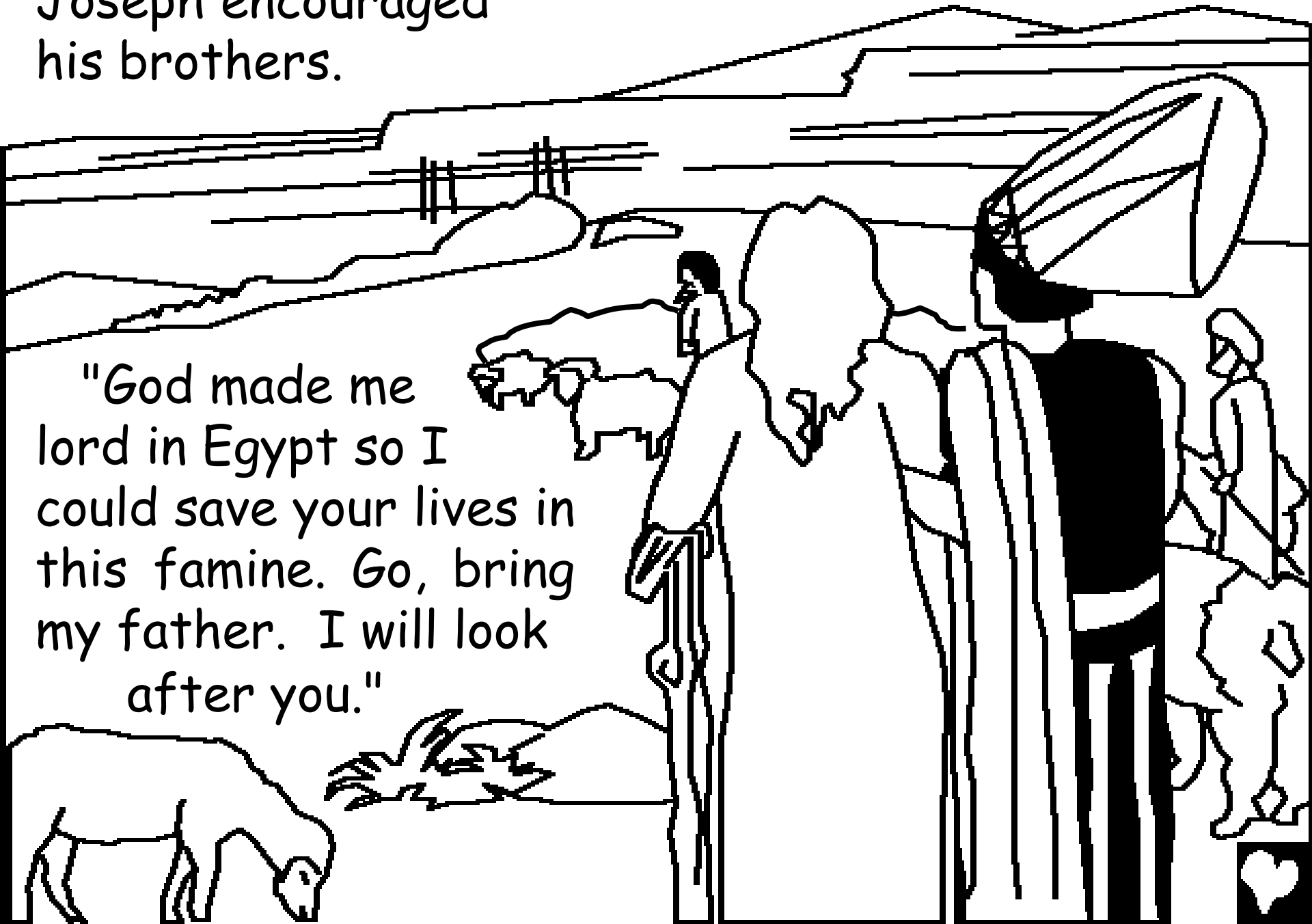
No longer able to hide his love for his family, Joseph sent all the Egyptians out. Then he began to weep. "I am Joseph your brother, whom you sold into Egypt."

Amazed and afraid, the brothers said nothing.

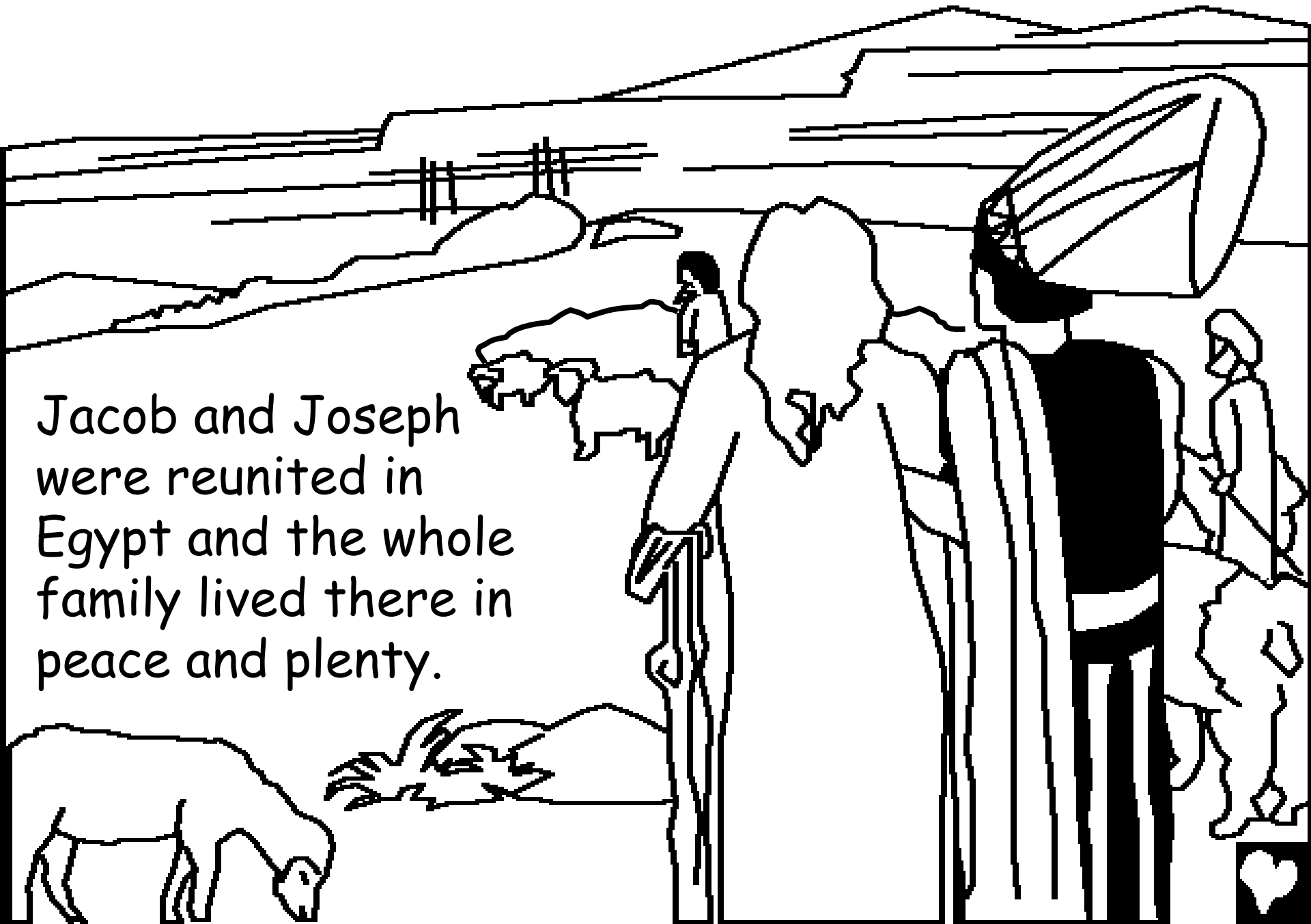

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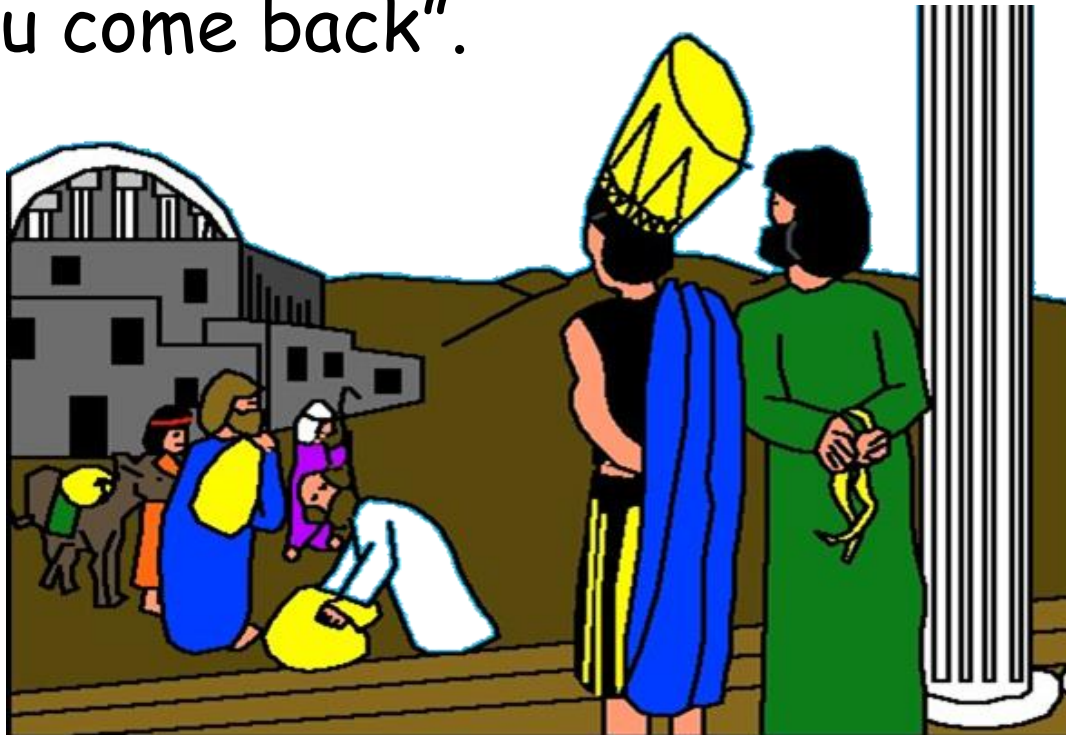
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Joseph's Family Reunion

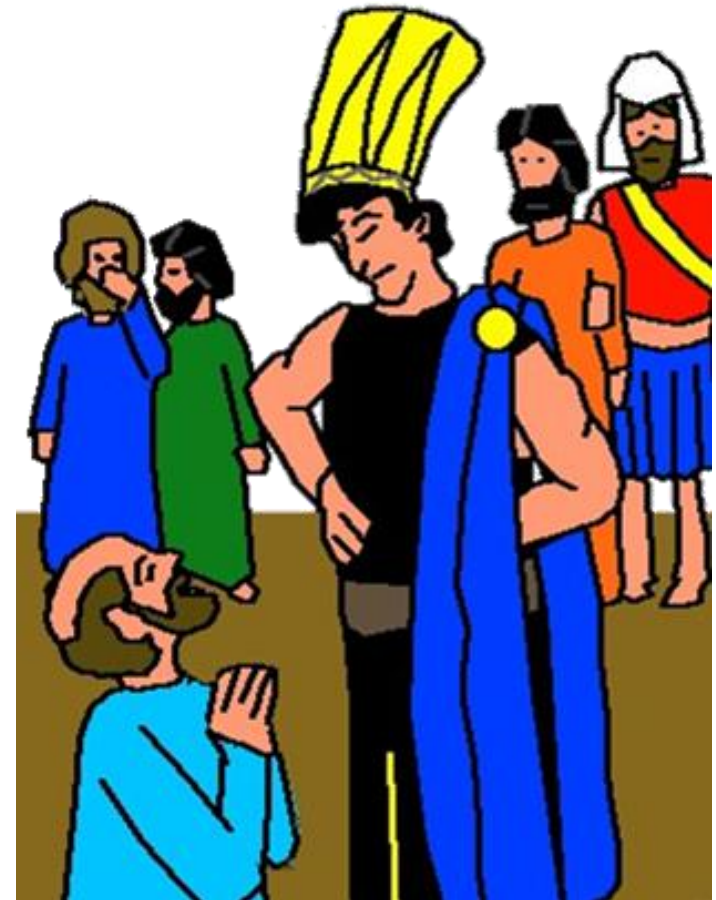


Joseph also wanted to know if his brothers were really sorry for their sin of many years before.

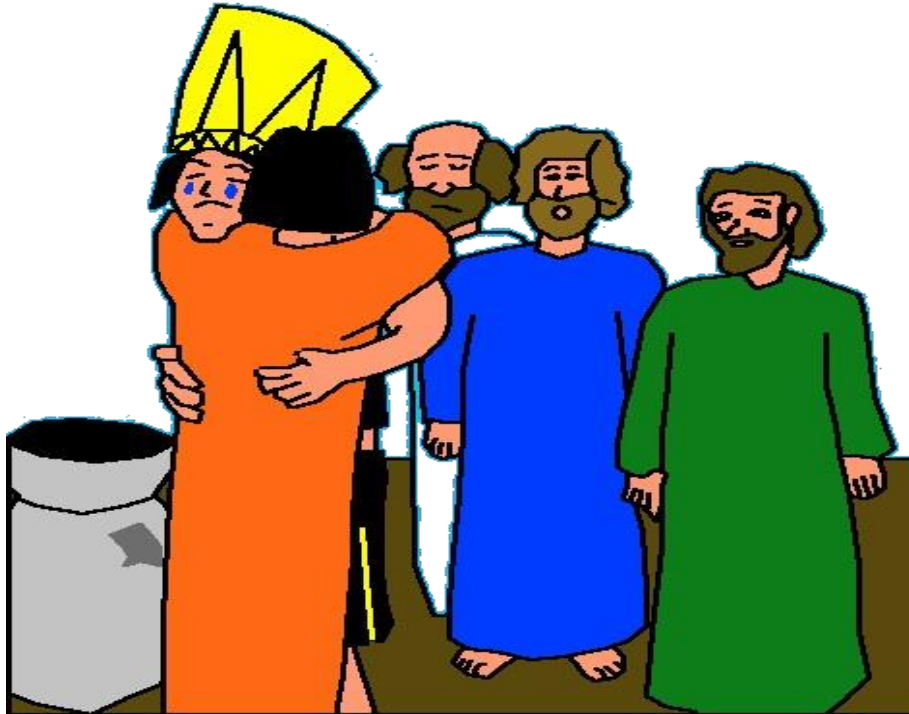
After the feast he said they had stolen his silver cup.

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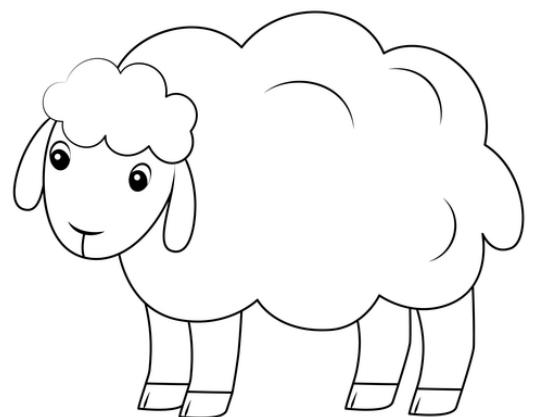
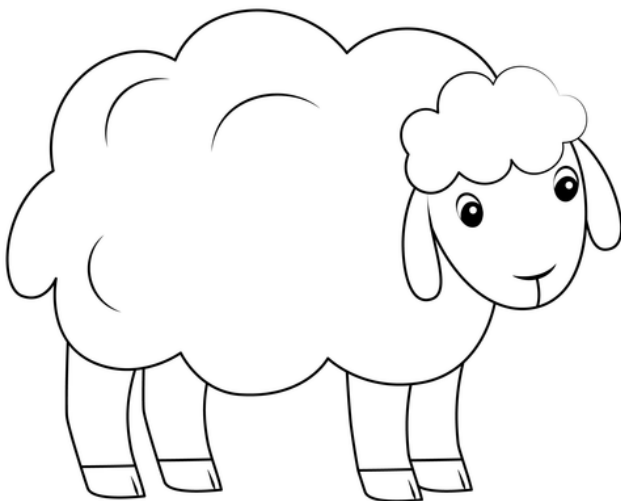
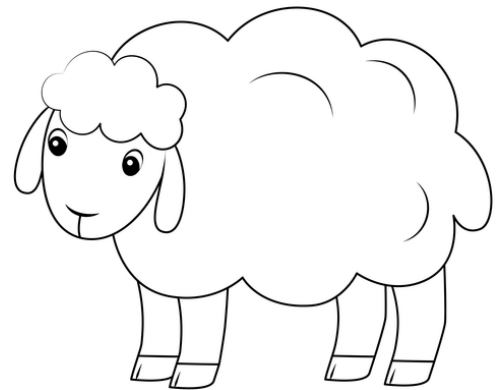
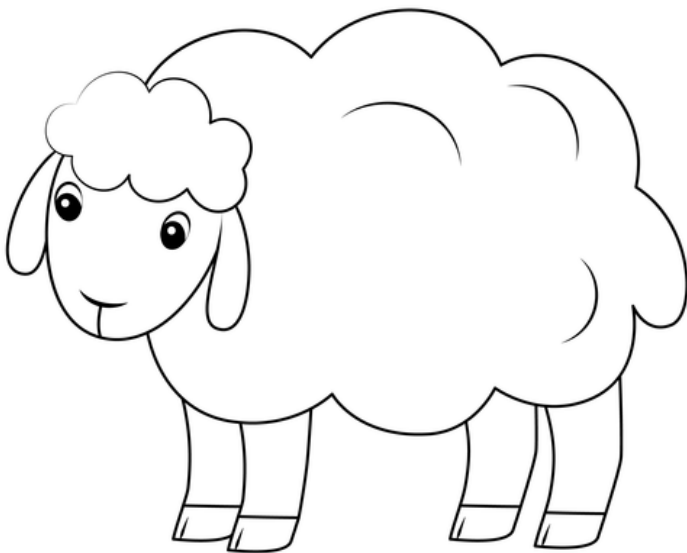
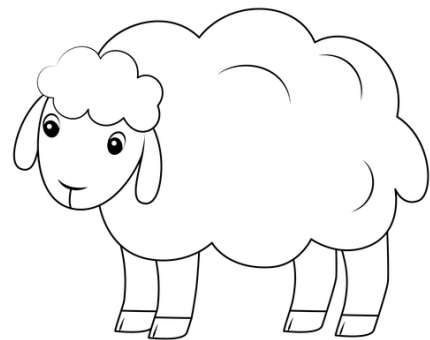
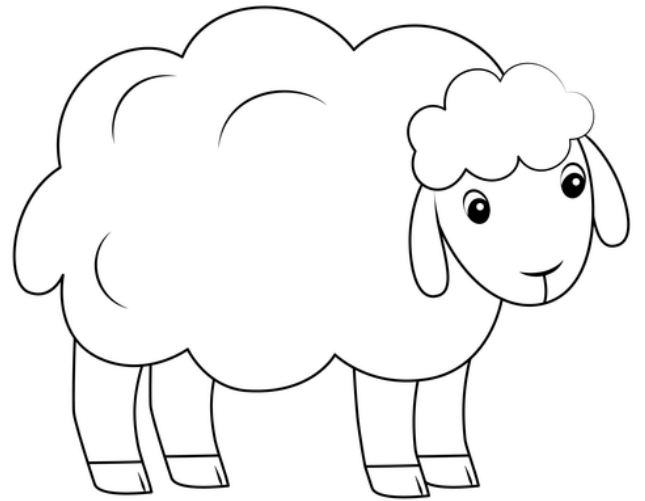
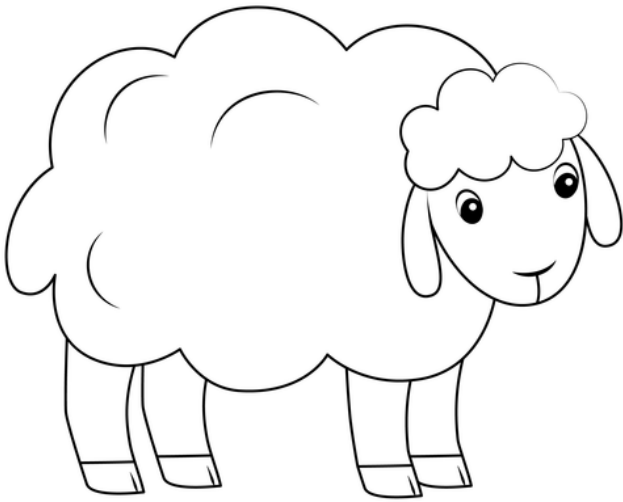
Gathering Loss Sheep
